Health is something that is easy to take for granted until it becomes a problem. Being unwell can cause difficulties in other parts of your life, like making it challenging to work or even pay for the high cost of health care. If you already have trouble making ends meet, the idea of not working for any period of time is a serious hardship. To see a health care professional, let

alone traveling great distances on foot (while you are very sick) to get treatment can be financially devastating to an entire family. This is the harsh reality for all

of the people we serve, and we have the ability to fix this problem for one person, forever, for less than \$5.

Tia has just finished its March project in Tizapan el Alto. We provided 10,000 new people with life-long access to free health care, provided by 56 local care givers. Trained by the UVM brigade and Tia Foundation, we equipped them with a versatile first aid toolbox. In total, the foundation has brought hope to



over 140,000 people with 376 resident health workers.

Our next project will be this summer from June 6th to the 10th in Tuxcueca, Jalisco. Just like our last project in Tizapan el Alto, this municipality is on the shores of Lake Chapala, Mexico's biggest freshwater lake. Tuxcueca has a rich, ancient history. It was mainly inhabited by the Chichimeca tribe before the Spanish conquest. This land was very sought after during the Saltpetre War by the King of Colima for its rich mineral deposits useful in the making



of gunpowder. Now the region is host to fisherman, livestock and farmers. The people here have a deep connection to their ancient roots and take great care to preserve their indigenous culture. Tia is excited to work hand in hand with these fine people.
