Generosity in Action

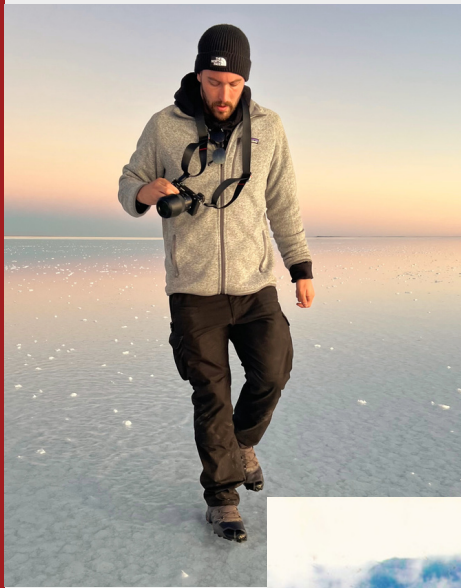
